## Required and Supporting Documents to be attached to the application

Only documents **in Italian or English** will be considered valid and will be assessed by the Admission Board. Identity documents and diplomas/degree certificates issued in a language other than Italian or English must be accompanied by an official translation. The translation must be carried out by an authorized body or by the awarding university. Only qualifications obtained in the last 5 years will be taken into account, with the exception of university degrees. The Admission Board will assess the relevance of the supporting documents to the PhD programme.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS	
<b>Identity document</b>	Valid identity document with photo (i.e. identity card, passport)
<b>Degrees</b>	Documents attesting the awarding of the first and second cycle degrees, the exams taken and the marks obtained (see Art. 3 of the Call for Applications)
<b>Curriculum Vitae</b>	The CV must be drawn up in English
<b>CV Summary</b>	Curriculum Vitae summary drawn up using exclusively the <a href="#">relevant form</a> , downloadable from the <a href="#">PhD programme Unibo webpage</a> . The form is a Word document: applicants are required to fill it using a computer (not by hand), save it as a .pdf and upload it on <a href="#">Studenti Online</a> .
<b>GRE Certificate</b>	Certificate of achievement in the GRE test ( <u>mandatory only for those applying for the Economics curriculum</u> )
SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS	
<b>Personal Statement</b>	The statement should include <b>the reasons why the applicant wishes to join the PhD programme and the relevant experience and research interests</b> that make the applicant suitable for the specific PhD programme (3000 characters maximum, including spaces).
<b>Reference Letter/s</b>	<b>No more than 3 reference letters</b> signed by <b>Italian and/or international academics and professionals</b> in the research field, which do not form part of the Admission Board, attesting the suitability of the applicant and his/her interest for the scientific research. Letters shall be uploaded following the procedure on <a href="#">Studenti Online</a> , detailed in the Call for Applications (Art. 3.2).
<b>Publications</b>	Full text publications (e.g. monographs, articles on scientific journals, volume chapters) – max 5
<b>Other documents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- English language proficiency certificates (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge Assessment)</li> <li>- Other qualifications attesting the suitability of the applicants (scholarships, prizes, etc.)</li> </ul>

## Evaluation criteria \*

Scores will be expressed in points out of 100, as follows.

- 1. Qualifications evaluation** - Minimum score for admission to the oral examination: 30 points, Maximum score: 50 points

Second cycle degree final mark. Graduates (or graduates coming from Universities that award degrees without a final mark) shall be evaluated on the basis of the Weighted Average Mark (WAM)	13 points max
Curriculum Vitae. This includes the academic prestige of the universities where the degrees, master and doctorate courses were held, reference letter(s), publications (if available), results of the GRE test, English language knowledge certified with IELTS, TOEFL or Cambridge Assessment	25 points max
Personal Statement	12 points max

- 2. Oral examination** - Minimum score for eligibility: 30 points, Maximum score 50 points

English proficiency	10 points max
General knowledge of the PhD programme's main research topics and of the research topics linked to the available PhD positions	40 points max

Oral examination aims to assess the suitability of the applicant for scientific research as well as the general knowledge of issues encompassed by the PhD Programme. **The oral examination is carried out in English.**
