Biosketch

I am a post-doctoral researcher at CNR-Istituto di Linguistica Computazionale "Antonio Zampolli" and lecturer in General Linguistics at Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna (Department of Modern Languages, Literatures, and Cultures). In my research, I adopt a cognitive approach to the study of language, with a specific focus on metaphors and their use for the representation of semantic contents and abstract concepts.
